It is informed to you vide above reference subject that, the proposal of giving permission to start new primary school to the educational institute mentioned below on the permanent non-aided basis from the academic year 2009-2010 at the place mentioned opposite to its name is under the consideration of this office.

Hence, it is informed to you to submit your report along with clear recommendations of the prescribed format by visiting personally to understand whether following conditions are fulfilled by the institute of not within 15 days to this office...

The orders regarding giving the permission/not giving the permission to the concerned institutes will be exited after receipt of your report only.

1. Concerned institute should be registered as per the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 or should be registered as per only the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950.
2. There should not be any serious complaints against the institute.
3. No recognition has been withdrawn of any of the school out of any primary / secondary school run by mentioned institute.
4. There have neither been any complaints regarding malpractice of any type in the concerned institute nor there is any case pending regarding taking possession of any of the schools run by the institute.
5. Financial condition of the institute is satisfactory.
6. The institute has made an application in the prescribed format with amended fees and there is no discrepancy in the name of the institute, place of school in the application.
7. The institute has paid penalty of Rs. 100/- for each academic year regarding keeping the school continued in spite of the non-approval of the Government.
8. The institute will complete the fulfillment of the documents for the due approval of the Government within three months.
9. The institute is required to charge fees as per the rate of educational fees prescribed by the Government in the school.
10. The Competent Officers are required to submit their opinion only after actual inspection of the classes being conducted in the school and number of students in them while giving recognition to the concerned institutes and the permission will be granted on the basis of the same only.

11. It is required to take a written guarantee letter on the stamp paper of Rs. 20/- that the institute will not start additional standards apart from the allowed no. of standards without permission of Competent Officers from the concerned institute.
12. The concerned school will not start the division of the medium other than that of permitted by the Government. In this regard as well, it is required to take a written guarantee letter on the stamp paper of Rs. 20/- from the concerned institute.
13. As per the provision in the Government Resolution No. SEN/2007/ (1001/2007) (3) SE-1, Date 19.10.2007, it will be binding for the school to start within eighteen months, which has been given permission vide the Government resolution. The resolution should be submitted accordingly if it is to be started within 18 months by the institute. In case the school has not been started in year 2009-10 and it is not to be started in future, then the institute is required to produce a letter accordingly to this office along with its opinion.
14. It is required to take a guarantee letter from the institute on the stamped bond paper of Rs. 20/- of the Court mentioning that the institute is ready to run the primary school of English medium on the permanently non-aided basis and the institute will not demand any aid from the Government in future and its Xerox copies should be preserved on the file permanently.
15. The institute should give the information of the teachers appointed in the school along with it (e.g. Name, caste, date of birth, date of appointment, educational qualification).
16. Following matters should be fulfilled as per the order given on the date 14 April 2009 by the Supreme Court in the Public Litigation No. 483/04.
 1. Fire fighting system should be installed within six months in the school.
 2. Inflammable and dangerous items should not be kept in the building of the school.
 3. Concerned staff and other employees of the school should be given necessary training in regard with the use of firefighting system.
 4. It should be assured that the building of the school being safe in all perspective and also, the school has been constructed as per the standards prescribed under National Building Code of India before giving the recognition and it will be responsibility of the Education Officer (Primary) to issue such certificate.
 5. Inspection of each school should be made in view of all the perspectives. Concerned officers should follow the National Building Code of India strictly. Disciplinary measures should be taken on the officials/employees who fail to carry out above jobs.

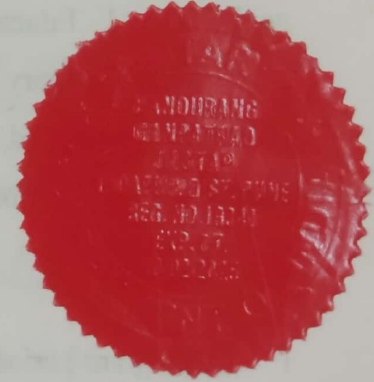

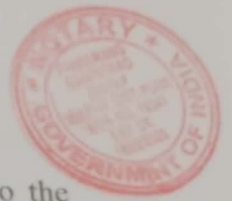

Subject:- To grant recognition to schools under Children's Right to free and compulsory education Act 2009 with the objective of section 18, Children's Right to free and compulsory education Act 2011 rule II, Sub rule (4).

As per your communication with school/inspection of school in respect of the your application, I, Education Officer (Primary), Pune Zilla Parishad, Pune, the provisional/temporary permission is given to Dattakala Education Society Swami Chincholi Tal- Daund, Dist- Pune Dattakala International School (C.B.S.E.) for 1st to 8th Std. for the period commencing from 1st of April 2019 to 31st of March 2022.

The above said grant is subject to the terms and conditions mentioned below.

1. The grant period shall not extend and there is no binding to give grant or attachment after 8th Std.
2. The school shall obey the Right to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure 1) and Maharashtra Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011(Annexure2)
3. The school shall give admission to the weaker section and deprived group children in first standard and on the limits of 25% of the number of students and shall give free and compulsory education to them till their completion of primary



education and also to comply the same in respect of pre-primary standard.

4. As per the Section 12(2) of the said Act, the fund is available to the school for the children mentioned in Para No. 3 and for receive the said fund, the school is provide separate bank account.

5. The school/society shall not recover any capitation fee and not to constrain the children or his/her mother-father or parents for any type of scrutiny.

6. The children shall not deny the admission in school for the reason of proof of age, religion, caste or birth of place or any of the said reason.

7. (one) The student which admission is given in standard, the said student shall not remain in said standard or not to oust/exclude from the school till his/her completion of primary education.

(two) Do not give any type of physical or mental torture or fine.

(three) It is not necessary to any children to pass any board's examination till completion of primary education.

(four) The certificate as prescribed under Rule 23 shall be given to the children who completed his/her primary education.

(five) The students who is disable/handicapped or special needy students include as per the provisions of said Act.

(six) The teacher who possess minimum qualification as prescribed under Section 23(1) of said Act shall appoint, but also that, those teacher who did not possess the minimum qualification at the time of beginning of the said Act, the said teacher shall possess/obtain the said minimum qualification within 5 years.

(seven) The teachers shall traverse his/her duty as mentioned in the Section 24(1) of said Act.

(eight) The teacher shall not engage himself/herself in private tuition/class, and the school precise the same.

8. The school shall obey the syllabus as prescribed by the School Appropriate Authority.



9. The school shall give admission to the students as per the available facilities as prescribed in Section 19 of the said Act.

10. The school shall obey the standards as prescribed in Section 19 of the said Act. The available facilities in school at the last time inspection are mentioned below:-

- Surrounding area of school: 14.7 Acre sq.mtr.
- Total construction area: 18108 sq.mtr.
- Area of Sports ground: 2 Acre sq.mtr.
- Number of classrooms : 24 classrooms
- Room of Headmaster-Store-Office: 3 rooms
- Separate toilet is available for girls and boys? Boys Girls
Toilet 10 10
Latrine 10 10

- Facility of drinking water: Yes
- Kitchen room for cooking of mid day meal: Not applicable
- Availability of studying, teaching material/ material of Sporting games/Library:
- Reading material available: yes (Book No. 5718 Newspaper...)

11. The classes or standard which is not grant, shall not run in school area of other place.

12. To use the building of school or other construction or Sports ground only for the purpose of education and technical skill development.

13. The school is run by the society/society registered as per the provisions of School Society Registration Act 1860 (21 of 1860) or Bombay Public Trust Act 1950.

14. The school shall not run for any person, group of person or any other persons' benefit nor for gain of profit.

15. The school audit shall carry out and certify from the Accountant and to prepare statements of account and one copy of every statement of account shall submit to the District Education Officer in every year.

16. Your school's U-DISE No. 27250401024, please mention the same while communication with this office.

17. The school shall submit report and information as demanded by the Hon'ble Director of Education/District Education Officer time to time or to obey the instruction given by Govt. or Local Authority for the fulfillment of terms of grant of school or to exclude the deficiency in the school work.
