MEMORANDUM

It is submitted that Khadki Cantonment Board is Statutory Autonomous Body functioning under the administrative control of Directorate General, Defence Estates, Ministry of Defence, Government of India, New Delhi. Cantonment Boards are constituted under the provision of the Cantonments Act, 2006 (Old Act of 1924) which is a Central Act passed by Parliament of India. Further as per Section 10(2) of the said Act, Cantonment Boards are deemed to be a Municipality under clause (e) of article 243-P of the Constitution for the purpose of -

receiving grants and allocations a)

implementing the Central Government schemes of social welfare, b) public health, hygiene, safety, water supply, sanitation, urban renewal and education.

- It is mandatory for all Cantonment Boards to provide municipal administration to all the residents of the Cantonment area, including the provisions which include imparting compulsory primary education to the children of the local residents of the Cantonment.
- Khadki Cantonment Board is running total eight schools under its 4. administration out of which four are Primary Schools & four are High Schools (Five Marathi medium & 2 Urdu Medium). Salary Grant is received from State Government Col.Bhagat English Medium School (Co-Ed) was for the three High Schools. established in the year 2010 following guidelines of "Right to Education Act" as there was huge public demand for an English Medium School for the local civilian children coming from economically weaker section of the society. Col.Bhagat English Medium School has to be got affiliated with State Board.

- 5. Col.Bhagat English Medium School has reached Class IX in this academic year 2018-19. Presently, the total strength of students of Pre-Primary & Std.I to Std.IX as on date is 767 (Boys 443 & Girls 324). As per the policy/decision of the Board, the School mainly caters the children who belong to poorest section of the society, families belonging to the Below Poverty Line (BPL) category residing in and around Khadki Cantonment.
- 7. It is requested that the Memorandum be considered and the State Board affiliation be granted to the said School which will benefit the children coming from the financially weaker session of the society in receiving quality education.
