




#### 3) Discussion and sharing of thoughts -

4) Various measures have been taken by the school to ensure the health and safety and security of all the students in the school.

leaves will not be granted.



▶ Dr, Ashwini Kulkarni further stated that at Nigdi branch they have initiated a drive: "Unplug to Restart" for students of std 5 to 10 where students will stop owning and using smart phones. Due to excess exposure to social media and use of technology there is a lot of disconnect between parents and children and together parents and school have to work to save our children from the

irreversible damage and addiction.

## Admission Process for the Academic Year 2023-24:

- As per Govt. norms all the remaining applicants will be selected through a lucky draw. Admission process for UKG to Higher standards for the academic year 2023-2024 will start after 16 Jan 2023, in case of vacancy only. Baseline test will be conducted as per the vacancy status. Admissions will be granted on merit basis only. Admission notice will be published on the school website [www.cityprideschool.com ] and the school notice board. Admission process for LKG for the academic year 2023-2024 will start in first week of December. Being a Konkani linguistic school, preference for LKG admissions will be given to Konkani linguistic students. Preference will be given to siblings and teacher's ward as well.
- Staff recruitment for the academic year 2023-2024 will be done as per the need analysis of the school for teaching and non-teaching staff.
  - Advertisement will be given in local newspaper for the same and it will be displayed on the school website as well.
     Interview, written exam and demo will be conducted accordingly for the

shortlisted candidates.

Ashwini madam stated that when a new teacher joins the organization she should be given some time to understand the working culture of the organization and to adjust with the new environment. ➤ AS PER MAHARASHTRA GOVT FEE REGULATION ACT-R NO MAHENG/2009/35528 DATED 26<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019 Page No 3

➤ (IA) The management of private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools may choose to declare at the time of admission to the students, the standard-wise fee structure for all the standards from first standard to the tenth standard. OR

(1B) The management of private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools who does not choose to declare the fee structure as per the provisions under sub-section (1A) shall be eligible to propose the fees in the school which shall not be more than previous academic year fee plus an amount of fifteen percent of the said fee. Provided that, the private unaided schools and permanently unaided schools may increase the fees after two years from the date the fee approved by the Executive Committee.

#### OR

- ➤ (1C) The management of the school may increase the fee provided in the fee structure as mentioned in sub-section (1A) or propose the fee higher than the rate as provided in sub-section (1B) or before two years as provided in the proviso to sub-section (1B), in unforeseen events, with the approval of 76 per cent of parents or approval of the Executive Committee by furnishing reasons or circumstances thereof.

Shwetangna Prakash, teacher representative, shared the following points:-

#### Change in School Timing 2021-22

- ▶ One more period is added to the time table of STD 3, 4 and 5 for languages and Mathematics.
- ► Accordingly the above mentioned classes will have 6 periods every day and their online classes will get over at 12:55 p.m.

#### **Sports Activities**

Sports activities are started in the morning as well as in the evening for STD: I - VI

- ▶ Students are given chance to play various games during this time.
- ▶ Sports activities for STD: 1& 2 will be starting after the Half Yearly Exam [From 11<sup>th</sup> October 2021]. Accordingly their assembly will start at 9:25 a.m. and then continue with the classes from 9:45 a.m.
- ▶ STD III VI will have a change in their breakfast schedule. It will be from 9:25 a.m. 9:40 a.m.to avoid the overlapping of periods of the same teacher.
- ► There won't be a separate breakfast timing for STD: 1 & 2.
- Accordingly there will be a change in the breakfast timing for all classes. Instead of 10:05a.m., it will at 9:25 a.m. so that STD:1 & 2 students can be accommodated in their class after the sports.

#### Sakal Activities

- ► Sakal Activities will be conducted this year for STD : 2 STD : 6.
- ► These activities will be conducted during regular school hours.

Dr. Ashwini K stated that parents requested that more practice for reading was required to be given to the students and hence the extra period is required and the extra time will not be used to complete the portion it is only for practice purpose and to complete the activities.

As sports clubs were given permission to conduct outdoor sports activities the school also decided to start sports activities for students in batches in the morning and in the evening and the response from parents as well as the students was very good.

The school has also started the reading activity. The library is open too and the students can take books monthly. The parents could also meet the teachers.



#### Point no.4 Fees Fixation:

> As per the Maharashtra Educational Institution (Regulation of fee) Act 2011, Section 6 of the Principal Act, sub-section (1B) the management of the private unaided school is eligible to propose the fee in the school which shall not be more than the previous academic year fee plus an amount of 15% of the said fee. The school can increase the fee after every two years.

Management Representative Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni informed the parents about the present fee structure of the school as follows:

- > As per the EPTA meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> of Oct 2020 all the EPTA members had unanimously approved that the fee for academic year 2021-2022 & 2022-23 would remain the same that is Rs.71,500/-.
- >Also all the class representatives of every class were taken into consideration and it was decided to keep the same fee structure for one more year that is 2022-23 as well.
- > The fee will remain the same i.e. Rs. 71,500/- as of 2021-22 for next year, 2022-23.
- > The fees for the academic year 2022-23 will be Rs. 71,500/- for all the students.

Thus the EPTA members approved to continue the fee structure for the academic year 2021-22 as well as 2022-23 as follows. The next fee rise will be for the academic year 2023-24

## Management Representative Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni also stated that

- > We also gave our parents flexibility in the dates for the payment of fees.
- > The due date for the first school fee installment was in the month of April 2021.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> fee installment date was extended from 10<sup>th</sup> June to 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> installment date was extended from 10<sup>th</sup> September to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

One more installment was added and the final fee installment would be 10th December 2021.

> So sufficient time was given to all the parents. We also took into consideration cases of certain parents who requested us to give them some more time to pay the fees.



Many of the parents have gone through financial crisis and the school was considerate and parents who approached the school with their problems were given some concession in the fees.

Parents facing financial crisis were given fee concession.

- One of the child master Sushant Nalgirkar lost his father to the covid-19, complete fee for academic year 2021-22 of Rs. 71,500/- was waived off.
- Few parents have not yet paid any of the installments for A.Y 21-22 in spite of this no child is stopped from attending the online classes or stopped from giving the exams.
- School from class 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> have started and after Diwali the govt. may take a decision to start class 5<sup>th</sup> onwards. The school is completely ready for its starting. Our teachers are already coming to school and the sanitisation in the school has been done regularly. Once we get the circular to start the school, one more EPTA meeting would be conducted to discuss the details of the reopening.
- In the previous meeting parents requested for concession in fee for one-time payment of fees, the decision regarding the same would be taken in the next EPTA meeting.
- Admissions will start in December 2021.
- Mrs. Vrushali Bhosale, teacher representative, informed the parents that even during the pandemic City Pride School have been paying full salary to all the teachers and even the class 4 staff on time with all benefits like PF since beginning. She appreciated that school also supported the few teachers by giving them laptops for online teaching. She said that such support to teachers from school management ensures bright future of school and motivates staff to work better.
- Neha Duggal: Class 4 representative stated that keeping in mind the discussions with the parents in the
  last meeting reading the fee structure, all the parents are happy with the current fee structure and the
  next years fee structure. She also expressed her gratitude as the school management is open to tackle
  every problem and provide a concrete solution always. As a class representative of 4<sup>th</sup> she accepted the
  proposed fee structure on behalf of Std. IV.
- Management Representative Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni also stated that all our staff are doing a lot of hardwork and so they are being paid their salaries on time and increment has also been given to the teachers. 2 years have been really difficult with the pandemic yet the students who remediation needed have been given it and with the support of the parents this would be one of the best schools in this area. The parents are very supportive and they whole heartedly participate in all the activities and our students will pass their 10<sup>th</sup> with flying colours and make us all feel proud. Though the fees can be increased by 15% every 2 years as per the rule, yet we have not increased it as much, but only the amount that is sufficient to pay the teachers well and maintain the school infrastructure.
- Mr. Chaitanya Balla, one of the EPTA members thanked the management and the Principal for keeping the same fee structure of Rs. 71,500/- for the academic years i.e. 2021-22 and 2022-23.
  - Mrs. Madhuri Guttikonda: appreciated the positive approach of the school towards all its stakeholders.
- Thus The EPTA members unanimously decided that the fees for the academic year 2022 23 as Rs.71,500/- by raising their hands online.



#### Point no. 5 Admission Process for year 2022-23:

- Being a Konkani Linguistic School, Konkani Linguistic students will be given direct admission.
- · Preference will be given to the siblings and teachers ward.
- After shortlisting the entries, a draw will be drawn in front of the parent representatives on a notified date and the students selected through the draw are given admission. She also informed that for further details regarding admission, the parents can visit school website.

#### Point no 6: Hiring of new staff:

Mrs. Shwetangna P stated that Staff recruitment [for teaching and non-teaching staff] for the academic year 2022-23 will be done as per the need analysis of the school.

- New teaching staff would be hired for the next academic year and she explained the entire process of hiring staff as follows:
- An advertisement is given in the newspaper regarding the hiring and the interested applicants can apply through the school website, then on a pre-decided date the written examination would be conducted the applicants who clear the written exam then would give a demo class and the applicants who qualify would then have a personal interview round. roint no. 3: Half Yearly Report: Mrs. Shwetangna. P presented the half yearly report of the school.

#### Point no.5 Academic Discussion:-

- i. The Principal appreciated the students who were a part of the competitive coaching classes last year. She stated that all the students have done exceptionally well, they excelled in the course.
- ii. Out of the 15 students for Mathematics competitive exam, most of them have crossed the first level the average marks secured is 70% it's a difficult exam & four to five students have got about 80 % the highest is 90% and last year's cut off is 62% so the overall result was excellent she further stated that it was a good teamwork of all the students and parents and hence the school could get a very good result in the competitive exam.
- iii. The Principal also added that these kind of extra activities is promoted in the school for the maximum benefit of the students and the student should not be stressed about these classes but should enjoy participating in these classes and this kind of coaching is given to the students so that Maths becomes easier for them at the higher levels
- iv. Due to the pandemic, scholarship coaching could not be done this year and suggestions were welcomed from the parents
- v. Mr. Vishal Kulkarni, class 5 EPTA asked for suggestions in regards with the competitive coaching, that is, how the entrance exam could be cracked at the first level, to this the Principal replied that the questions are based on the previous year portion and it is conceptual based.


