With reference to your letter No. 155 dated 7th Nov.

1948, on the subjects noted above, I have the honour to inform you that in view of the need of the school for the refugee pupils, who have been established here and in view of the circumstances reported by you, the Navin Hind Maha Vidyalaya, ~~Poona~~ Poona, is recognised as teaching standards I to VII in Sindhi and Standards I to IV in Hindi for the year 1948-49, on the following conditions:-

- 1) The school may be shifted to a separate building in the near future.
- 2) The rates of fees should be charged as laid down by the Secondary Schools' Committee's report.
- 3) Government Provident Fund Scheme, should be introduced for the benefit of teachers.
- 4) Service conditions and leave rules should be framed and submitted for ~~the~~ approval of ~~the~~ the Department.
- 5) The suggestions made and the defects pointed out in the Inspection Report by the Assistant E.I.C.D., Poona, under the ~~the~~ various paragraphs of the I.R. should be carried out and remedied before the next inspection of the school.
