Sir,  
I have the honour to state that it is understood that your school has been recognised by the Parishad Education Officer, Zilla Parishad, as a full-fledged High School i.e. teaching Standards upto and inclusive XI with effect from June 1965. If so, your school is eligible to present candidates for the S.S.C. Examination of March 1966 and onwards so long as your school continues to be recognised by the Parishad Education Officer purpose of the S.S.C. Examination each school eligible to present candidates at the S.S.C. Examination is given an 'INDEX NUMBER' which is required to be quoted in all correspondence with the Board and in such forms and returns as are to be submitted to this office by the school in connection with the examination. The Index Number assigned to your school is 11/183 which should be quoted by you in all the relevant correspondence with the Board.

2/- In this connection, I am to add that every recognised High School presenting candidates for the S.S.C. Examination has to remit to the Board an Annual Registration Fee as required under Regulation 26 (a) of the Maharashtra S.S.C. Examination Regulations. If, therefore, your school presents candidates for the S.S.C. Examination of March 1966, I request that you will be so good as to remit the amount of Rs.10/- by Money Order towards the Annual Registration Fee for the year 1965 - 1966. The Money Order so remitted should clearly bear in the money order coupon itself the name of the School, the Index No. of the School and purpose for which the Money Order is sent viz. 'Annual Registration' for the school year 1965-1966. A copy of the syllabus and the relevant circulars etc., are being sent to you gratis separately.
