































### 3<sup>rd</sup> PTA COMMITTEE MEETING

### 5) Structure of the Fees for 2023-24 & 2024-25

Principal sir put forth the fee structure for 2 years as per norms i.e. 2023-24 and 2024-25 with 14.93% raise. The structure is tabulated and compared on the next page.

It was stated that the school had not raised the fee for last 2 years and that it is due for a rise from the next academic year. The committee was of the opinion that raising the structure by 15% at one time is not advisable and suggested the following options to be communicated to the management:-

- 1) Rise of 10% may be considered for entire 2 years  
OR
- 2) Raise of 7.5% for the academic year 2023-24 and subsequently remaining 7.5% for the academic year 2024-25, but to be calculated on the basis of 2022-23 Fee structure. Principal sir agreed to communicate the message with the management to agree upon one of the



options suggested above.

6) Any other point with the permission of the chair -

a) Principal sir explained the committee members the introduction of the skill subjects for classes VI to X and their requirement as elicited in the NEP 2020.

We are implementing - Financial literacy for class VI  
Travel and Tourism for class VII  
Artificial Intelligence for class VIII  
IT for classes IX and X.

b) It has been discussed that the staff receives the trainings and inputs through the lesson observations, cross checking of the notebooks etc. Principal sir added that he, himself has recently attended the Masters' Training from CBSE on the - Highlights of NEP. He clarified certain doubts of the PTA members through the discussion.

c) Parents expressed that the students should be introduced to the professional skills through the expert's talk, counseling sessions etc. Principal sir informed that it has been thought of, as the same has been discussed with the Police Department as well.

d) The point of Foreign language teaching has been discussed with the reference of compulsory learning of Marathi language as per Maharashtra Govt's G.R.



- e) Mr. Ashish Chaudhary expressed his concern for Class IX A. A few students misbehaving with the teacher in the class. It has been assured that a strict action will be taken after proper enquiry.
- f) There were few requests from the members for canteen facility in the school campus so that it will be convenient for the working parents. This inconvenience results into parents sending the junk food in the tiffin. Principal sir assured the members of the further positive action with this regard.
- g) Principal sir explained the PTA members the school Development Plan (SDP), its implementation in the six major areas & proudly announced the leadership team has been appreciated for the accomplishments of SDP goals during Term-I Review meeting.

- i) SMART CARDS for parents - It was stated that in order to enhance safety and security of students, no child will be handed over to the parent without this Smart Card. The member appreciated the decision.
