शासन निर्णय:- शासन परिपत्रक दि.२९ एप्रिल २००८ अन्वये राज्यात कायम विनाअनुदान तत्वावर प्राथमिक, माध्यमिक व उच्च माध्यमिक शाळा, सुरु करण्याकरिता खाजगी शैक्षणिक संस्थांकडून प्रस्ताव मागविण्यात आले होते. त्या अनुषंगाने इंग्रजी माध्यमाच्या प्राथमिक शाळा सुरु करण्याबाबत प्राप्त प्रस्तावांपैकी ज्या प्रस्तावांवर जिल्हा समिती व राज्य समिती, या पैकी एक समितीच्या शिफारशी आहेत अशा १,१८३ इंग्रजी माध्यमाच्या प्राथमिक शाळांना सन २००९-१० पासून इयत्ता पहिलीच्या वर्गास (फक्त एका तुकडीस) कायम विनाअनुदान तत्वावर व भविष्यात माध्यम बदलता येणार नाही या अटीवर प्राथमिक शाळा सुरु करण्यास परवानगी देण्यात येत आहे. या शासन निर्णयासोबत संस्थेची नावे व शाळेचे नाव व ठिकाण प्रपत्रामध्ये जोडली आहे.

२. कायम विनाअनुदान तत्वावर परवानगी देण्यात आलेल्या या शाळांना कोणत्याही स्वरूपाचे अनुदान शासनाकडून देय असणार नाही.



५. कायम विनाअनुदान तत्वावर परवानगी देण्यात आलेल्या सहपत्रात नमूद सर्व शाळांना शासनाच्या सर्व संबंधित कायदे व नियमांची अंमलबजावणी करणे बंधनकारक राहिल.

Sir,

I am directed to forward herewith the application received from, Aaryan's School, at Aaryan's Valley, Satara Road, Bhillarewadi, Dist. Pune run by Ellora Medicals and Educational foundation, Aaryan's Corner, Satara Road, Balaji Nagar, Dhankawadi, Dist. Pune alongwith enclosures in original to CBSE, New Delhi and to state that this Government have "No Objection" to accord affiliation to the school subject to fulfilment of the following conditions.

1. This No objection certificate will remain valid only for a period of 3 years. It will be binding on institution to get renewal of No Objection Certificate after a period of every three years. The first, No objection certificate will be issued at the Government level and the renewal of No objection certificate will be done after every three years at the level of concerned Deputy Director of Education.
2. The State Government reserves the right to withdraw the above certificate at any time without giving prior notice and without assigning any reason if any deviation of rules reported in future and the management falls to comply with the instructions of the State Government.
3. Admission should be made with the bonafide dates of birth certificate.
4. The management should collect the tuition fee and special fee etc. as prescribed by Fee Regulation Committee appointed by the State Government .
5. The strength in classes should be as per rule in force prescribed for English medium schools.
6. The management should follow the State Board syllabus for Classes from 1 to 5th..
7. The school should follow the three language formula till 8th Standard and Marathi as U language.
8. The District Educational Officer or his nominee should be invited when the management makes recruitment of candidates for various categories of posts.
9. Staff salaries should be paid as per Government Scales of pay.

10. The management should not collect donations either from the students or from parents.
 11. The management should implement the provident fund scheme.
 12. No pupil studying in the school now be put to hardship for continuing in the same school.
 13. It will be mandatory for the school to provide information about the details of classes and number of students to Education Officer (Primary and Secondary) before 31st August of each academic year.
 14. No classes should be opened without prior sanction /permission from the Education Officer (Primary and Secondary).
 15. The management shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police. Fire Services and the Transport Department from time to time. The instructions issued in Cir. Memo. No. 21748/D1/97 dated 16.2.1998 and other orders of transport department for safe transportation of school children should be scrupulously followed.
 16. The management should provide fire protection arrangement as prescribed in the National Building Code of India part IV fire Protection 1997 and it's amendments from time to time.
 17. They should abide by the State Government Acts, rule, regulations and orders issued from time to time.
 18. The school shall not be eligible for any kind of financial grant-in-aid from the Government and must be run only on self financing basis.
 19. The no objection certificate is applicable till class XII; Provided the school must apply to renewal after a period of every 3 years as mentioned in clause (1) .
 20. The State Government reserves the rights to carry out academic /audit inspection of the school. It will be mandatory to the school to provide any information at any time required by the Government.

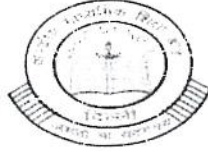

With reference to your online application dated **24.06.2009** on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the sanction for Composite Provisional Affiliation for Secondary School Examination of the Board for a period of **three years w.e.f. 01.04.2010 to 31.03.2013.**

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. "School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes".
2. The school will follow syllabi and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
3. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII :-

(d)	School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.			

2. The School will not sponsor candidates for Board's examination of any other School/Branch, which is not affiliated.

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3. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
4. **The school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.**
5. **Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.**
6. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
7. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
8. The school will spare sufficient teachers, for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required
9. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
10. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
11. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
12. **The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.**
13. **The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act -1995'.**
14. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
15. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.
16. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
17. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
18. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
19. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **1130218**. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
20. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws/Rules of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in the joint names.
21. **Annual fee of Rs. 4500/- @ Rs.1500/- per annum for three years (01.04.2010 to 31.03.2013) be also remitted at an early date. (In case of overseas Independent school @ Rs. 5000/- p.a. and overseas Kendriya Vidyalayas @ Rs. 3500/- p.a.)**
22. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on online' through www.cbseaff.nic.in with the prescribed fee of **Rs. 12,500/-** and other essential documents before 30th June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation.

23. The school will open CBSE pattern classes IX w.e.f. 2010. Accordingly, 1st Batch of class X of the school will be appeared at the Board's Examination to be held in the year 2012.
24. **The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X Examination from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to *suo moto* withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.**

25. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

26. **Special conditions to be complied within three months:**

1. The average enrollment in ~~all~~ ^{few} sections are high. Therefore the school is required to maintain optimum section wise strength for each class.
2. The school is required to pay pay-scales, DA and other admissible allowances at least par with the corresponding categories of employees working in the State Govt. schools as per Affiliation Bye-laws.
3. The school is having some untrained teachers therefore the school is required to appoint only trained and qualified teachers as per norms prescribed by CBSE.
4. The school is required to appoint a qualified Librarian.
5. The school is required to establish Mathematics Laboratory.
6. The school has not submitted the proof of EPF scheme implemented for its employees and EPF code number allotted to the school has not been mentioned.
