MINUTES OF THE MEETING

- 1) **Welcoming of parents:-** Principal Dr. Mrs. Sunita Chavan welcomed all PTA members and our Founder President. Principal Madam took a short review of the points discussed in the 1st PTA meeting.
- 2) **Discussion about Unit test and Semester i exam. pattern**
School has conducted first Unit test and conducting class tests (mock tests) weekly to which parents also agreed.
- 3) **Discussion about weak students**
 - Weak students' parents meetings were conducted (standard wise) and explained them about exam pattern (Semester I). Techniques were taught to parents so that they can take studies at home.[Parents were told to concentrate first on objective questions and then on subjective]. Principal Madam explained with the help of paper pattern as to how easy passing is if students study as expressed in meeting.
 - English language point was highlighted to speak and write in easy way. In order to improve language skill daily teachers are sending new words along with the sentences on what's app group. Pronunciation is also send. Parents are expected to see that students are writing and using those words while communicating.
 - She discussed about school is paying for MCF activity and Abacus activity. Our school is giving these activities free of cost. Parents to make sure that students don't remain at home unnecessarily and should take advantage of such activities.

- Our Management wants our students to work out mental maths easily and do quick calculation. Abacus assessment will be scheduled before Semester I.

4) Discussion about Annual Function (2022-23)

Annual function will be in the month of January for 2 days. School will ask parents to pay for drapery only. School doesn't charge any extra amount for Annual function.

5) Discussion about II Unit test

Second Unit test will be conducted in last week of January or first week of February. Parents will be informed accordingly.

6) Discussion about raise in fees for academic year 2023-24

Fee hike was in 2019-20 but after that due to Pandemic school Management didn't increase fees since last 4 years. For next academic year 2023-24 Management has decided to increase fee as per given below:-

Std : I to IV	-	Rs.3000/-
Std : V to VII	-	Rs.3500/-
Std : VIII to X	-	Rs.4000/-

After that our Founder President Shri Kakasaheb Chavan Sir stood to speak with parents and he briefed about following points.

- 1) Sir asked all PTA member parents that are our school activities and academics working out as per planning? All parents expressed positively that they are very happy with the functioning of school and execution of all plans.

Sir asked if any suggestions parents have. He strictly instructed all parents that their unnecessary demands won't be fulfilled by Management. All parents have to follow school rules but if their suggestions are good then those can be given a second thought.

- 2) Sir expressed that in comparison with other schools our school's fee is very reasonable. No school in Dhayari area is offering MCF activities and Abacus free of cost. But still parents are not paying school fees in time still school need to recover 50/60 lakhs pending during pandemic from parents. Sir questioned all PTA members that if parents didn't pay school fee in time then how it is possible for our Management to bear other expenses and payment of teachers. In this case then Management may have to lose good teachers.
- 3) Main aim of school is to make each student self-disciplined, respectful, nation lover, obedient, hard worker and all-rounder. Just to fulfill all these needs school is teaching Dance, Tabla, Music, Computer, Drawing, Craft, MCF activities, Abacus to students along with main subjects without charging for the same.
- 4) Considering the Pandemic disorder and 'parents' situation Management curtailed 15% of fees for academic year 2021-22. Apart from that still parents have not paid school fees in time. Huge back log of fees is seen.
- 5) Introduction related to discipline was put forth by Sir as parents to take care of student's uniform and hairstyle. Students should look smart, descent when they arrive in our school campus.
- 6) Sir expressed that nowadays parents are busy but parents need to take studies and see that they do well. Child's study is not responsibility of school only. It is an association between parents and school. School expects parent's co-operation for the best results.
- 7) Parents agreed to the rise in fees structure for academic year 2023-24 and expressed their approval by raising their hands.
- 8) Principal Madam thanked our Founder President and all the parents for attending meeting.
