8	<p>Grade representative gave several suggestions to help school achieve the holistic development of our students like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Weekly there should be one dedicated period to teach and help student develop life skills cultural values.</li> </ul>
9	<p>Grade 1 representatives spoke about discipline issue in bus. To answer this question Chairperson said the teachers who avails the bus also takes the responsibility of the bus discipline and they will ensure that students are seated well.</p>
10	<p>Grade representative mentioned about the flaws in NEO Track. To answer this question Chairperson informed that management has decided to replace NEO Track with a new app for the next academic year.</p>
11	<p>Grade representative inquired whether SPA &amp; PSA sessions will be there after Grade 7 when dedicated board wise curriculum students will have from Grade 8. To answer this question Chairperson said students will have SPA and those who want to avail PSA can also do that. Only for SPA number of sessions in a week will be different than earlier. There will be only 1 SPA session of 70 min in a week.</p>
12	<p>Grade representative asked whether we will have summer camp this year as well for students. To answer this question Chairperson said like last year this year as well we will have summer camp for students and those who want to enrol for those activities.</p>
13	<p>Grade 4 representative suggested that Computer subject's syllabus needs to be changed. Chairperson said that we are already working on it and it will be changed for the academic year 2024-'25.</p>
14	<p>Grade 1 representative suggested that school must update the parents about various things happening in school through school broadcast group. For example, sharing photos of Pest control done in school which will give parents as well the confidence about the proper care taken by management and the hygiene maintained in canteen etc.</p>
15	<p>Grade 4 representative gave a suggestion and requested if EPTA members can be given the permission in broadcast group to send messages, that way they can share the things discussed in EPTA and if required answer any parents doubt if that was discussed in meeting or the parent is aware of it through the circular and messages sent from school.</p>
16	<p>Grade representative gave a suggestion related to VIVA concert wherein participants couldn't watch the whole show until the video was shared by the school. So next time, if possible, some arrangement should be done through which one screen can be there for the participants to watch the show.</p>
17	<p>Chairperson invited all the EPTA members for the 75<sup>th</sup> Republic Day celebration in school for which formal invitation was also shared with all parents through WhatsApp broadcast group.</p>
