MINUTES OF THE MEETING held on Saturday, 14th January 2023 at 9.30 a.m.

Venue - Std VIII Jasmine/Rose classroom on the office floor

- After the parents assembled in the classroom Anita teacher (Teacher's Representative) took the signature of the PTA members.
- Anita Jashi (Suraksha teacher) HM welcomed the PTA members
- Delicious Breakfast of Sabudana khichadi, Tilachi vadi and coffee was served to all immediately after the PTA members assembled in the class.
- Agenda of the meeting was:

A) Republic Day Celebration

B) School Fees Revision for the Academic year 2023-24

- HM briefed the PTA members on preparation and required help for the Republic day celebration on our school ground wherein the Chief Guest invited is Rtd Capt Nitin Welde, an alumnus of our school.

- HM informed the PTA members that the Republic Day celebration is an extravagant event where along with the Abhinava Primary session, the Pre-Primary and High School staff and students will also be participating in the celebration.

- HM informed the PTA members that there will be performances by students of all the three schools

- A rehearsal for the same will be conducted on the previous day.

- A circular regarding the same will also be shared soon.

- PTA Members can volunteer help for the smooth functioning of the Republic Day celebration.

- Dispersal will be in batches. No parents, no cyclists, no four wheelers will be allowed in the school premises.

- A list of questions were asked by some PTA representatives and duly answered by the HM

PTA : Appealed for a long rope and suggested that the rope should be detangled prior to it's use.

HM : Gave assurance that the needful will be done with the help of PT teachers.

HM : Appealed to the members not to commute in 4 wheelers on 26th January.

PTA : Can one gate be allotted for exit only?

HM : Not convenient with the quantum of so many people present.

PTA : Can other parents volunteer?

HM : Suggested that 48 members should suffice.

PTA : Can the PTA members of Pre-primary and High School volunteer help for the smooth functioning of the event?

HM : Announced that she would talk to the Principals of the other two schools and get back to the PTA members in a day or two.

PTA : Brought to the notice that they will get trained for the event and get badges done for identification.

HM : Again highlighted on important points like:

- Children will be distributed between New and Old Basements and 5th to 8th will be distributed in the classrooms in the old building. New Building will be shut completely.
- As the number is very large, this year, ex-students and other parents will not be allowed in the campus. Only PTA members will be allowed.
- 9:40 am onwards dispersal will start.
- Batch by batch dispersal will be done.
- Both gates will be open for exit.
- Parents and Teachers are requested not to bring 4-wheelers.
- Children are requested not to come by bicycles as there will be no space for parking. If they do come, they will need to park outside.
- Only Grp Capt Nitin Welde's car should be allowed inside.
- Teachers and school staff will get badges for identification
- Corridors of the school will be decorated with Republic Day and the forthcoming Sports Day celebration.
- Ropes for parking will be untangled beforehand
- School is arranging professional sound and video technicians
- HM invited the PTA members for coffee and a group photograph after the event gets over

- School Fees Revision for 2023-2024

- HM : Brought to the attention of PTA members that according to Govt norms, every 2 years the school has the permission to revise the school fees.

- Last fee revision was in the year 2018, so in 2023, school has decided to revise the school fees by 15%. Even computer fees will be revised after a gap of 14 years.

- HM specified that the school has been considerate during the pandemic and waived off fees for students whose families suffered heavy financial losses.


- In the academic year 2022-23, 15% fees were waived off as well.

- HM highlighted on Government norms where the school has to follow certain protocols and get approval from PTA members for fee revision and then the document on Revision of fees will be submitted to Govt and ZP officials.

- HM read out the circular of Revision of School Tuition and Computer Fees.

Annual Fees of 46,000/- for 1st to 8th and Computer Fees for 2,500 - for Std II to Std V

- All the PTA members unanimously agreed to the Revision of Fees in unison.

PTA : Stressed on the point that our school has the lowest fee structure as compared to the other schools where their fee structure is 1 lakh or more annually.

PTA : NO DONATION POLICY is strictly followed by the school which is truly appreciable and appreciated the Transparency with which the school has always been functioning.

PTA : Suggested that school should officially make an announcement regarding the 'Revision of Fees'.

HM : Assured that will definitely do so after the approval from the PTA members.

PTA : Praised the school for it's ingenious work and conducting the online sessions diligently as compared to the other schools.

HM : Proudly appreciated the efforts taken by the teachers and also spoke about the help procured from family members. Power point presentations made by teachers were authentic and checked by HOD's before sharing them with the students.

HM : School ensured that Education of the students was not hindered and thanked the parents profusely for their support and understanding.

HM : Read the official letter regarding revision of School fees and asked the

PTA VP and Joint Secretary to sign the Fee Revision Circular which they did so without any inhibitions.

PTA : - Cancelling the Annual Social Gathering was understood but why was the field trip cancelled was raised.

HM - Clarified that stringent rules are laid by the Government like child's medical insurance, parent's consent and use of only state transport buses was imposed. Hence reviewing this the school decided not to conduct a field trip, but had a movie session for children which they thoroughly enjoyed with their classmates.

PTA : The movie shown for Std I 'Taare Zameen Par' wasn't meant for kids of that particular age group.

HM : The movie was organised by the PMC hence it was mandatory for the school to show it nevertheless the school had already shown the kids another movie on the Fun Day.

PTA : Std V parents had a doubt with concepts for Hindi and Marathi subjects as the students failed to understand.

HM : Assured that she will look into the matter at the earliest and said that experienced /senior teachers already are going and explaining important concepts in some classes.

PTA : Weight of school bags is too heavy for students of Std II. Allot a particular day to carry dictionary to school.

HM : Promised to convey this to Std II teachers and guide them accordingly.

PTA : Some students have neck pain and back problems.

HM : Clarified that School has given norms for weight of bag. Students and parents are requested to follow the timetable and books. Students tend to bring extra books for tuition classes, Scholarship classes (Std V and VIII) etc. hence leading to increase in weight of the school bag.

PTA : Std III suggested that Portion and Time Table of the examinations conducted should be shared a month in advance and also date last for last working day should be announced well in advance.

HM : Teachers already mark the lessons in the textbook and its well understood that whatever is taught prior to the exams will be a part of the portion for the exams conducted. Portion will be shared 15 days in advance of exams. Secondly dates for the examination are bound to change at times if some Government exams come up at the last moment. Regarding the last working day for this academic year is 12-Apr-2023 which is well in advance shared on the ELP groups.

PTA : Some concepts in Mathematics like perimeter + Area should to be brushed up. Maths statements to be given etc. Correction issues in some classes need to be resolved.

HM : Gave assurance that the matter will be looked into and resolved at the earliest.

HM : Declared the end of the meeting by thanking the PTA members for their invaluable support.
