#### Commencement

1) The meeting started with the warm welcome extended by the Headmistress Mrs. Philomena Gaikwad. Anecdotes from newspapers were given to imbibe the welfare of the children in the mind of the parents, teachers' efforts were appreciated and freedom about the bonding between the teacher and the student was also mentioned. The PRs were informed about the start of the school for std I – VII. Details about the arrangements for the students to attend was also shared.
