

I PTA Meeting

2-8-2024

Minutes of I PTA meeting for the year 2024-25.

8:30 to 10:10

Meeting started with a silent prayer.

Fr. Shoby Mathew OIC, Principal welcomed new PTA Body and explained role of PTA. He compared a PTA body with bridge. He invited them to work together with management. Fr. also explained school needs support and co-operation of parents. Again Fr. reminded PTA that they should not put any message on Whatsapp directly. Parents should follow proper channel. They need to meet concern authorities. PTA should understand their duty and responsibilities. he also explained school has their own problems. School with parents have joint venture and that is betterment of children. So Fr. appealed for co-operation of PTA members and not to play blame game. Fr. informed about upcoming programs :-

1. Teachers' Day Celebration - There is need to acknowledge teacher's hard work. PTA has to plan for the same.
2. AI Exhibition - It will take place in the last week of November. Fr. explained it is not a normal exhibition. It will require high cost because it will be a mega-event. Budget will be five to six lacs. Planning for 60 plus projects - Estimated. Four to five students will be assigned for one project. This will be two days programme. Schools in vicinity will be invited for the same. There will be food stalls. It will be in the form of FUN-FAIR. Publicity of the event is entrusted to the PTA.
3. Kid's Day - Kid's day will be celebrated for pre-primary students and they will be participating in it.
4. As per festivals, celebrations will take place time to time.
5. Fr. also informed about newly constructed Auditorium, Library and AI Laboratory. Fr. also requested members to have a look for the same.
6. Remedial classes also will start after I Unit test, but as per past experience few parents are seen neutral towards such type of arrangements eg. extra-classes, which provide help to students. Students remain absent and parents do not co-operate. Classes for high school grades will be held 12.20 pm to 1.10 pm. For Primary sections classes will be from 12 pm to 1 pm. After monsoon classes will be held for K.G. sections.

7. Dr. shared good news of achieving 100% result of SSC and HSC. Dr. also explained that for HSC achieving 100% is not easy since students come through centralized admission process from different schools. He also expressed his happiness because more than 50% Nirmal School students have taken admission for 11th std. in Jr. College. Dr. also informed the Nirmal Jr. College also started giving admission for integrated courses with some private coaching centre. Teachers conduct Practicals and English Classes on Saturdays.
8. Information will be shared with PTA time to time.
9. In all four PTA meetings will be there during this academic year. So we expect cent percent attendance.

Meeting was thrown open to the members -

Fees payment was explained

Dr. also informed about Jawaharlal Navodaya Schools entrance test. Whoever is interested can apply. Few parents told about the students who bring bikes. School should not give them parking place. On this Dr. said school is not providing such type of facility. The students also said that parents should not give them bikes.

One of the members suggested to conduct I semester examinations quite before vacation, so that students can enjoy the festivals. Dr. explained, school needs to follow government's guidelines, it is not in school's hand.

Few parents asked to give AI fees receipt.

Few parents complained and raised the parking issue of vehicles while dropping their wards. Few of them suggested to use different gates for entry and exit. One of the parents suggested to promote sports, indoor games competitions and training should be given to students.

Celebration of programs should be kept separate from exams since children get -lined and can't study. Teachers should teach Moral Values.

Mrs. Reema Shewil shared detailed information with members of AI Exhibition.

Mr. Raykumar informed to start Cadet Cops training (NCC).

Meeting ended at 10 am.

Minutes of the Second PTA Meeting - 2024-25

23rd Nov, 2024.

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The meeting commenced with a silent prayer. Fr. appreciated the unwavering support of PTA members.

Agenda: AI Exhibition.

This will be the first AI Exhibition of its kind in Pune, scheduled for 28th and 29th November 2024.

Inauguration:

Date: 27th November 2024.

Time: 7.30 PM (One-hour program)

Exhibition Details:

63 projects will be displayed.

270 participants will be involved.

10 projects will be shortlisted for the final round.

Prizes:-

1st Prize: ₹ 25,000

2nd Prize: ₹ 15,000

3rd Prize: ₹ 10,000

Prize distribution and closing ceremony will take place on 29th November, 2024.

Food stalls will be arranged by external vendors for both days.

Annual Sports Meet: There will be Annual Sports Meet on 4th December 2024 at Maurya Kridasankul, Chinchwad.

Examinations:

Preliminary exams are starting from 12th December 2024 for 12th grade.

For SSC exams are starting from 2nd January 2025.

Board exams will start from 11th February 2025 while for SSC it will start from 21st February 2025.

Fr. announced that the school store will be closed soon.

To instill the value of charity, Fr. proposed organizing support programs for the needy with PTA's assistance. For December, Grade 9 students will take part in a charity event.

Remedial Classes:-

Due to poor participation from parents and students, remedial classes had been temporarily stopped. These will resume after the unit-tests.

Fr. also shared information about the picnic schedule:

For 10th and 12th std. - in December.

For remaining classes it is scheduled in January.

Key Updates :

1. Invitation Cards :

Distribution will be class-wise, as different time slots are allocated to different classes for the exhibition.

2. Food Arrangements:-

Meals are arranged for both days for participants and staff.

3. Volunteer Assistance:-

Fr. requested help from a few PTA volunteers for the exhibition day.

Discussion Points by Mr. Raj Gupta:

1. Protection Awareness:

Suggestion: Conduct counseling sessions for girls.

Explanation: The school already has a qualified counselor conducting regular sessions for girls.

2. CCTV Installation:-

Suggestion: Install CCTV cameras throughout the school and ensure they are functional.

Explanation: Cameras are already installed.

3. Exam Seating Arrangement

Suggestion: Ensure proper exam seating arrangements.

4. Washroom Hygiene

Suggestion: Maintain cleanliness in washrooms.

Explanation: Washrooms are cleaned twice daily.

5. Reduction in Bag Weight

Suggestion: Structure the timetable to reduce the number of books students need to carry.

Explanation: This is currently under consideration.

6. PTA Fund Transparency

PTA members want access to the details of PTA fund usage.

7. Bag Quality

The quality of new school bags is not satisfactory, with weak handles reported.

8. School App Updates

Regular updates on the school app, including homework and other necessary information.

9. Favoritism in Tuitions

Parents expressed concern that some teachers favor students who attend their private tuitions, which demoralizes other students.

10. Transportation Safety

Management was urged to take necessary steps to ensure the safety of students by private transportation.

11. Classroom Infrastructure

Parents highlighted the issue of overcrowded classrooms, with students being forced to sit beyond bench capacity.

They suggested increasing the number of benches to accommodate all students comfortably.

12. Home-work and Book Checking

Teachers should regularly check students' books and pay attention to spellings.

General mistakes in notebooks should be rectified. Homework updates should be shared in groups daily and checked at least once a week.

13. Moral Science and General Knowledge

Parents suggested teaching Moral Science and GK before

the semester begins.

14. Staff Verification:

Concerns were raised regarding the need for proper verification of supportive staff.

15. Foreign language introduction:
Parents suggested to include foreign languages in the curriculum.

Management responded that it could be introduced as an extracurricular activity and would be considered further.

16. PTA Member Attendance:

The issue of absenteeism among PTA members was discussed.

A suggestion was made to have one male and one female representative grade wise.

17. Teaching Methods in 8th Grade:

Some parents complained that certain teachers ask students to write notes before teaching the topic.

18. Stress Management Seminar:

Management announced plans to organize a seminar for stress management and motivation, specifically for 10th and 12th grade students.

19. Exam Timings:

A request was made to change exam timings for students.

Management clarified that this would cause transportation issues.

20. Olympiad and Scholarship Preparation:

Parents requested extra classes for Olympiad and scholarship exam preparation.
